- ☑ A listing in the Arts Directory (published annually – 25,000 copies distributed throughout the County and at Tourism Centres in Central Ontario) and on the Arts Council website.
- ☑ An opportunity to purchase an enhanced listing in the Arts Directory which includes a photograph or logo and description of your arts practice, business or organization; directions to your studio/place of business; plus a locator marker on the map (if you have a location that people can visit).
- ☑ A discount on Arts Council workshops.

- ☑ The opportunity to promote your events, workshops, website, news, job postings etc in the Arts Council monthly listings – an e-bulletin distributed to over 600 e-mail addresses including media contacts, the County Tourism office, owners of hospitality businesses in the County
- ☑ The opportunity to participate in other co-operative marketing initiatives
- ☑ Promotion at the Art-in-the-Streets demonstrations held throughout the summer on the main street of the village of Haliburton and at special events throughout the County.
